NORTH EAST INDOOR ROWING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2009 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Entries should be returned to Matt Pearce, C/O Durham University Boat Club, Maiden Castle, Durham University, Durham, DH1 3SE. To arrive no later than 1st December 2009. Cheques should be made payable to 'Durham University Boat Club'.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- By entering the competition, a competitor agrees to be bound by the rules.
- Concept II Indoor Rowers will be used. Competitors may use the resistance level of their choice, but this cannot be changed during the race. It is recommended that trialists set their machines to the following drag factor: Men = 135, Women = 130
- Minimum age for competitors is 16
- For all competitors age is as of race day
- Lightweight event limits: Men 75kg or less, women 61.5kg or less, lightweight competitors will be weighed at registration between 2 hours and 1 hour prior to their race time.
 Competitors entered into a lightweight race who do not make weight will be able to race, but their time will be placed in the heavyweight results
- No competitor will be allowed to change event on the day of racing, not withstanding the above rule
- The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Eligibility

- Allcomers: Open to all athletes
- Freshers: Open to any athlete that has not rowed before August 1st 2009
- College: Open to all members of a Durham College who are not a current member of the University Boat Club
- University: Open to all athletes who are full members of a University, as defined by BUSA
- Veteran: The Concept II handicapping system will be applied to all veteran results

Team Events

The following rule applies to the Northcroft ergo challenge

- Teams are made up of four members of the same sex, you have one ergo and need to cover 3000m. Each member must be involved, you may recruit extra people to hold feet etc, but no one other than the 4 competitors may touch the ergo handle.
- A separate Durham Colleges prize will be offered provided 3 or more teams enter. Eligibility is the same as for the individual event.
- DCR Novice cup entries must all have competed in the 2009 Novice cup.
