PARTICULARS

Candidates must:

- Coach multiple novice and lower boat outings each week, primarily weekday mornings and weekends.
- Be available during Torpids (late Feb) and Summer 8s (late May) as well as develop a training programme in the lead up to these races.
- Have an approachable and supportive attitude and be passionate about developing novice and intermediate athletes.

It would be desirable for candidates to have:

- Significant rowing and/or coaching experience, ideally at a university level or higher.
- Availability to coach across all three terms.
- · Prior experience of Oxford bumps racing.
- · Good knowledge of rigging and boat setup.
