RESPONSIBILITIES

- Coach one land and two water-based sessions per week
- Coach regattas, both Oxford based and external
- Communicate with captains and other coaches to allow progression through the boat club, and to arrange crews for outings and races
- Teach rowing and coxing to complete novices
- Develop the technique of less experienced members of the boat club

ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

- Available during term times from October 2023 to June 2024
- Available weekday mornings and weekends for coaching and regattas
- Able to provide technical and individual feedback to both rowers and coxes
- Have previous coaching experience

DESIRABLE CRITERIA

- Familiar with Oxford rowing, particularly the Isis and bumps racing
- Able to remain encouraging during outings
- Available for pre-season training camps
- Ability to drive a launch, re-rig boats, and adjust equipment
- Available to coach both on the Isis and at Godstow
- Experience coxing and/or training novice coxes
