The Championships will provide a target for encouraging and retaining junior and senior members

> INSPIRING CHANGE

Creating opportunities to showcase relevant issues such as inclusivity and sustainability



WHAT WILL CONSTITUTE A SUCCESSFUL JUNIOR & SENIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS?

AN INCLUSIVE EVENT

- Championship, Club and Beginner senior events
- Appropriate boat types for each level
- At least one lightweight, mixed and adaptive event from year one (subject to minimum entry)
- Flexible entry crews, rather than athletes, will be entered to reduce drop out
- Entry fees are affordable

A HIGH QUALITY AND REWARDING EXPERIENCE FOR ALL ATTENDEES

- Athletes: Ideal minimum of two races per crew, with the potential to win gold, silver or bronze medals
- Volunteers: Engage and activate both local and club volunteers with rewards for their time, such as T-shirts and meals
- Umpires: Incentivise attendance with expense support and regatta facilities
- Spectators: Stay up-to-date with the racing with live race information and commentary, online streaming and a variety of off-water activities

EXECUTIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Plan and progressively develop year on year
- Leverage professional staff to engage and activate membership community
- Build on success of existing British Rowing Junior Championships
- Show leadership on sustainability
