

Annual Anti-Doping Report

September 2023 - August 2024

Introduction

This report provides a summary of anti-doping activities undertaken by British Rowing between September 2023 and August 2024.

UK Anti-Doping require all national governing bodies to demonstrate ongoing compliance with its Assurance Framework. British Rowing received confirmation of ongoing compliance in Spring 2024.

Education

During this period, 1138, individuals have received face to face education and 239 e-learning modules were completed. This included training for:

Outreach

In the last year, we have been present at 5 different outreach events, speaking to athletes, coaches, parents and others about British Rowing and our Clean Sport programme. These have been delivered at British Rowing events including British Rowing Indoor Champiosnhips, National Schools Regatta, and the British Junior and Senior Championships.

Communications

Updates on matters concerning anti-doping are provided periodically through the member newsletter. Key messages continue to be disseminated through social media channels and directly to performance pathway coaches and athletes, including updates concerning the Prohibited List, reminders to use Global DRO and Informed Sport as anti-doping tools available to support athletes in ensuring they take part in rowing clean.

British Rowing joined UK Anti-Doping's Clean Sport Week 2024 campaign, with a video developed featuring members of the GB Rowing Team in the build up to the Paris Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Testing and Results Management

Testing of athletes in British Rowing is undertaken on behalf of either the UK Anti-Doping, or World Rowing testing programmes.

There has been one ADRV occurring during the 2023-24 period. This was the result of an athlete using a prescribed prohibited substance for the treatment of a legitimate medical condition, without having obtained a Therapeutic Use Exempion (TUE).
